

# **End User License Agreement**

# PopcornSAR Cloud IDE

The End User License Agreement (EULA) defines the rights granted by PopcornSAR and its affiliates to the user for the use of the software PopcornSAR Cloud IDE, a proprietary software tool. This includes related materials provided by PopcornSAR, such as documentation and demonstration material, under the license grant. The user is permitted to make archival and backup copies of the software. Key provisions of the agreement include

#### 1. Grant of License

- Grant of a non-exclusive, perpetual, non-transferable, non-sublicensable, revocable right to use PopcornSAR Cloud IDE.
- Permission to make archival and backup copies included.

#### 2. Usage Restrictions

- Prohibitions on using, copying, modifying, translating, reverse engineering, or disassembling
  PopcornSAR Cloud IDE.
- Creation of derivative works is not allowed.
- o Prohibition on renting, leasing, sublicensing, transferring, or distributing the software.
- Usage may be limited to a specified number of simultaneous executions depending on the license model.

## 3. Ownership Rights of Licensor

- o PopcornSAR retains all rights and ownership related to PopcornSAR Cloud IDE.
- o Exclusive ownership of trademarks, logos, and product names is acknowledged.
- o Prohibition on removing or modifying any copyright or proprietary notices from the software.

#### 4. Warranty and Liability Limitations

- PopcornSAR Cloud IDE use is subject to warranty and liability terms as specified or agreed upon.
- Warranty only covers defects deliberately concealed by the licensor if the license is provided for free
- o Liability is only for damages caused by deliberate or grossly negligent acts.
- o Claims under applicable product liability laws are unaffected.

#### 5. Submissions by License

- The licensee is not obligated to provide PopcornSAR with any materials related to PopcornSAR Cloud IDE.
- o All communications submitted are treated as non-confidential and non-proprietary.
- PopcornSAR is granted the right to use such communications for both commercial and noncommercial purposes.

### 6. Inclusion of Third-Party Programs

- o PopcornSAR Cloud IDE may include third-party programs or materials.
- o Compliance with third-party license terms is required.

#### 7. Legal and Export Compliance

- Compliance with all applicable export laws and regulations.
- o Prohibition on illegal export or re-export of the software.

#### 8. General Provisions

- o The remainder of the agreement remains in effect if parts are invalidated.
- Changes to the agreement are only valid if made through mutual written consent.
