



Beta Service Terms

These Beta Service Terms supplement and are made a part of the terms of the existing AWS Customer Agreement (available at <https://aws.amazon.com/agreement>) or other written agreement between you (“**Customer**”) and Amazon Web Services, Inc (“**AWS**”) that governs Customer’s use of the services (the “**Agreement**”). By accessing or using IDP Premium, Customer agrees to be bound by these Beta Service Terms. If Customer does not agree, Customer may not use IDP Premium. This tool is not available to the general public and is provided as a Beta Service as defined in the AWS Service Terms.

In the event of a conflict between these terms and conditions and the Agreement, these additional terms and conditions will govern. Capitalized terms used but not defined in these additional terms and conditions have the meanings given in the Agreement.

1. **Beta Service.** IDP Premium is an add-on feature to the IDP accelerator that includes (a) an artificial intelligence agent that automates prompt configuration and extraction optimization of new documents and (b) an operational dashboard providing visibility into documents processed, cost per page, extraction accuracy, failure rates, and reprocessing triggers (“**Beta Service**”).
2. **Beta License.** Subject to the terms and conditions of these Beta Service Terms, AWS hereby grants Customer a non-exclusive, non-sublicensable, and non-transferable license during the Term to: (a) use the Beta Service solely for Customer’s internal evaluation purposes and in accordance with documentations and instructions provided by AWS; and (b) use the related content that AWS may provide related to the Beta Service provided to Customer in any format (“**Beta Content**”) solely for Customer’s internal evaluation purposes in connection with Customer’s use of the Beta Service.
3. **Beta License Restrictions.** Customer will not use the Beta Service or Beta Content for any purposes beyond the scope of the license granted herein. Without limiting the foregoing and except as otherwise expressly set forth herein, Customer will not at any time, directly or indirectly:
 - a. copy, modify, or create derivative works of the Beta Service or Beta Content, in whole or in part;
 - b. rent, lease, lend, sell, sublicense, assign, distribute, publish, transfer, commercialize, or otherwise make available the Beta Service or Beta Content;
 - c. reverse engineer, disassemble, decompile, decode, adapt, or otherwise attempt to derive or gain access to the source code of the Beta Service, in whole or in part;
 - d. remove any proprietary notices from the Beta Service or Beta Content;
 - e. use the Beta Service in any manner or for any purpose that infringes, misappropriates, or otherwise violates any intellectual property right or other right of any person, or that violates any applicable law;
 - f. process Regulated Data (including health information, payment card data, government-issued identifiers, children's data, or export-controlled data) without AWS's prior written consent;



- g. disclose or publish the results of any benchmark or performance testing of the Beta Service to anyone other than AWS; or
 - h. use the Beta Service to build or train models or products that compete with AWS Services.
- 4. **Delivery.** AWS will make Beta Service features available to Customer for download and deployment within Customer's AWS environment.
- 5. **Term and Termination.** The license term to the Beta Service and Beta Content will commence on the date Customer first accesses the Beta Service and, unless terminated earlier pursuant to the terms herein, will continue in effect for six months thereafter ("**Term**"). AWS may terminate these Beta Service Terms immediately upon written notice to Customer if Customer breaches any term or condition of these Beta Service Terms, including but not limited to the Beta License Restrictions, and fails to cure such breach within five (5) days after receiving written notice thereof from AWS; provided, however, that AWS may terminate these Beta Service Terms immediately without a cure period if the breach is of the Beta License Restrictions, confidentiality obligations related to the subject matter herein, or is otherwise incapable of cure.
- 6. **Effect of Termination.** Upon expiration or termination of these Beta Service Terms, Customer's license and access rights to the Beta Service herein terminate immediately. Customer must (a) immediately cease using the Beta Service and Beta Content, and (b) Customer must permanently delete or destroy all copies of the Beta Service and Beta Content and deliver to AWS a written certification, signed by an authorized officer of Customer, confirming such deletion or destruction is complete.
- 7. **Evaluation Fee.** Customer's access to the Beta Service and Beta Content during the Term will be at no additional cost.
- 8. **Evaluation and Feedback.** The Customer will meet at a minimum monthly with AWS or at any other cadence designated by AWS to discuss the Beta Service and Beta Content. During these sessions, Customer will provide feedback on the Beta Service and Beta Content, which will include (a) overall benefits, (b) ease of use, (c) interface design, (d) feature gaps or enhancement requests, and (e) specific metrics to inform pricing and positioning, including documents/ page volume, accuracy, and cost metrics.
- 9. **Additional Terms and Conditions.**
 - a. Beta Service functionality, features and documentation may change when the Beta Service is made generally available.
 - b. Nothing in these Beta Service Terms obligate AWS to make the Beta Service or any similar service generally available, and Customer acknowledges that any future offering, if any, may differ in functionality, terms, and pricing from the Beta Service provided hereunder.
 - c. The existence of the Beta Service and Beta Content constitute AWS Confidential Information. Customer must not (a) disclose AWS Confidential Information to any third party without AWS's prior written consent, or (b) discuss the features, functionality, or documentation related to the Beta Service and Beta Content with any third party without



AWS's prior written consent. Customer's confidentiality obligations survive termination of these Beta Service Terms.

- d. No service levels, uptime commitments, or support obligations apply during the Term.
