



## TERMS FOR PURCHASES THROUGH AWS MARKETPLACE

1. **The Agreement:** Customer's subscription purchased through the AWS Marketplace is governed by the Business Terms of Service found at <https://1password.com/legal/terms-of-service>, unless Customer has a written Service Agreement executed with 1Password, in which case such Service Agreement will govern (the governing agreement defined as the "Agreement") and 1Password's Data Processing Addendum, currently available at <https://1password.com/legal-center/DPA>.
2. **Special Terms:** The use of and access to the 1Password Services provided by 1Password to Customer shall be purchased by Customer through the AWS Marketplace and such sale shall be subject to the payment terms and conditions between Amazon Web Services, Inc. ("AWS") and Customer. Customer will remit fee(s) to AWS, and AWS will revert such fee(s) to 1Password in accordance with any applicable agreement(s) between 1Password and AWS. For the avoidance of doubt, Customer will not be responsible for remitting fee(s) to 1Password directly. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein or in the AWS Marketplace Agreement, the Agreement shall govern the use of and access to the 1Password Services and the amount of fees due for the use of and access to the 1Password Services.
3. **Duration of Services:** The Customer subscribes to the 1Password Services for the duration as noted in AWS Marketplace.
4. **Number of Users:** Pricing will be based on the number of Users. 1Password shall regularly review the Customer's account and if it exceeds the Number of Users purchased, 1Password will send an invoice for the applicable Fees for the additional Users.
5. **XAM Specific Terms:** If the Customer is purchasing 1Password's Extended Access Management (XAM) product, the definition of "Services" under the Agreement will be deemed to include XAM. Use of 1Password's XAM product is subject to Product-Specific Terms, available at <http://1password.com/legal-center/PSTs>. This Section 5 is of no force or effect if Customer is not purchasing XAM.
